Her adventures are riddled with bouts of imagined malaria and real spells of gastro-intestinal difficulties.

She chronicles her entertaining stories with no excuses or apologies, until she sends the sanitized postcards home to her parents. After all, why worry them?

Janita and her husband Roddy embarked on a similar journey in 2001. "I was inspired to write this book for several reasons," says Van de Velde. "I wanted to give readers something to laugh about, because we could all use a little more humour in our lives. I also find it funny that no matter how old we get, we still attempt to hide the whole truth from our parents. It took me a while to realize that my parents know me better than anyone else on this planet." Although the book is a work of fiction, it's loosely based on their adventures. She's not telling which stories are real and which ones are complete fabrications. She'll leave that up to your imagination!

Janita Van de Velde grew up on a farm near Mariapolis, Manitoba. She holds a Bachelor of Science degree in agricultural economics from the University of Manitoba and has worked for a financial institution since graduating.
